

ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHATTANOOGA CITY CODE,  
CHAPTER 20, SECTION 20-146, RELATIVE TO MOBILE  
FOOD UNITS.

WHEREAS, the City of Chattanooga began a mobile food program on March 20, 2012;

WHEREAS, the mobile food program has been a success but will sunset on March 20, 2013, unless the program is extended or made permanent;

WHEREAS, the City of Chattanooga desires to extend and expand the mobile food program to include trailers and to make it permanent;

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, That Chattanooga City Code, Chapter 20, Section 20-146, Definitions, relating to “Mobile food unit”, by deleting same and substituting in lieu thereof the following:

”*Mobile food unit*” means any motorized vehicle or trailer attached to a motorized vehicle that includes a self-contained kitchen in which food is prepared or processed and from which food is sold or dispensed to the ultimate consumer. Mobile food units must be mobile and on wheels at all times during operation. A trailer shall remain attached to its towing vehicle at all times. Mobile food units must be removed from authorized operating locations in permitted zones when not in use and between the hours of 12:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. This definition does not include vehicles operating under a special event permit or waterfront concession agreement.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, That Chattanooga City Code, Chapter 20, Section 20-151, shall be deleted in its entirety.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
