2013 TENNESSEE JAG ALLOCATIONS

Listed below are all jurisdictions in the state that are eligible for FY 2013 JAG funding, as determined by the JAG formula. If your jurisdiction is listed with another city or county government in a shaded area, you are in a funding disparity. In this case, the units of local government must develop a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) and apply for an award with a single, joint application.

Finding your jurisdiction:(1) Disparate jurisdictions are listed in shaded groups below, in alphabetic order by county.(2) Eligible individual allocations are listed alphabetically below the shaded, disparate groupings.

Counties that have an asterisk (*) under the "Eligible Individual Allocation" column did not submit the level of violent crime data to qualify for a direct award from BJA, but are in the disparate grouping indicated by the shaded area. The JAG legislation requires these counties to remain a partner with the local jurisdictions receiving funds and must be a signatory on the required Memorandum of Understanding (MOU). Disparate jurisdictions do not need to abide by the listed individual allocations, which are provided for information only. MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

2013 JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT

WHEREAS, the City of Chattanooga and Hamilton County Government are recipients of a 2013 Justice Assistance Grant award ("Grant") in amount equal to \$131,441.00; and

WHEREAS, each governing body finds that this agreement is in the best interest of all parties, that the project will benefit the public, and that the division of awards fairly compensates each party under this agreement;

NOW THEREFORE, the City and County agree as follows:

1. The City of Chattanooga will act as applicant and fiscal agent for the joint request;
2. The City of Chattanooga shall receive an amount equal to \$88,139.00 and such amount shall be disbursed in the manner set forth in Attachment A;
3. Hamilton County shall receive an amount equal to \$43,302.00 and such amount shall be disbursed in the manner set forth in Attachment A and more specifically, for the purchase of a hostage negotiation van;
4. Each party will ensure they use the funds in a manner consistent with the requirements of the Grant
