

Councilman Hakeem,

I'm Debie Mikel, Technology Manager for Public Works & the liaison between City and Hamilton County GIS - we work on addressing as a team.

I also work with Lee Norris & Bill Payne and the other Management/Staff in Public works on all Technology needs; and am the Public Works liaison to the IS Department.

This email is in regard to an address change that was approved by Bill Payne City Engineer and he will be bringing it forward to the Council for approval in the next several weeks.

The 3200 to 3299 Block of Dell Trail is a broken Street segment – Dell Trail does not go through to Dell Trail in Glendon Place.

The 2 property owners have requested and are in favor of the name change due to potential problems for Emergency Responders not being able to find them and they are having continual problems with deliveries FEDEX, UPS etc looking for them on the other side of Dell Trail in Glendon Place which is not a through street.

The name change was in process prior to the new Council Administration.

I spoke with one of the property owners today (Mrs. Young) & they are anxious to have the change made as they are having legal paperwork drawn up and want to have the correct address name on their paperwork.
