A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FIRE CHIEF TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH TENNESSEE AMERICAN WATER COMPANY TO PAY FOR THE INSTALLATION OF HYDRANTS AT THE DIRECTION OF THE FIRE CHIEF WHICH WILL BE OWNED, INSTALLED, AND MAINTAINED BY TENNESSEE AMERICAN WATER COMPANY AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$200,000.00).

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, That the Fire Chief be and is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Tennessee American Water Company to pay for the installation of hydrants at the direction of the Fire Chief which will be owned, installed, and maintained by Tennessee American Water Company at a cost not to exceed \$200,000.00.

RE: Installation of public Fire Hydrants at Different Locations within the City of Chattanooga, Purchased by the City of Chattanooga

Dear Mr. Flint:

Tennessee-American Water Company has been requested to provide a cost estimate for the installation of public fire hydrants within the City of Chattanooga. Because each fire hydrant installation is unique, the cost of each fire hydrant will vary. Since a set price per fire hydrant is not available, Tennessee-American Water Company will provide fire hydrants under a budget not to exceed \$200,000.00. Tennessee-American Water Company will install public fire hydrants until the budget is depleted.

Tennessee-American Water will require payment for the cost of each fire hydrant installation after the job is completed. After the fire hydrants are installed, Tennessee-American Water Company will bill the City of Chattanooga quarterly for the completed fire hydrants.

Tennessee-American Water Company, or its contractors, will install the fire hydrants. Tennessee-American Water Company will own and maintain the fire hydrants after installation. The City of Chattanooga shall pay for the fire hydrants and installation of the fire hydrants. The Rules and Regulations of Tennessee-American Water Company as approved by TRA, shall apply to all installations of public fire hydrants and the provision of fire service by way of public fire hydrants.

In order to proceed with the purchase and installation of the public fire hydrants, which are non-refundable, please sign the letter in the space below. Your signature below indicates your agreement (1) for Tennessee-American Water Company to install, own, and maintain the fire hydrants, and (2) The City of Chattanooga to pay the cost of fire hydrants installation. Return a copy of the signed letter back to us for our records.
