

PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT

E-11-008-802

The City of Chattanooga and Triad Electric Company, agent for Southern Surgical Arts, agree to enter into a Partnership Agreement for the property located at 1405 Cowart Street in conjunction with the Cowart Street Streetscape Project, this agreement shall be known as Project No. E-11-008-802. The City and Triad Electric agree that each party has certain responsibilities to make this project succeed. The following responsibilities of each party are as follows:

Triad Electric Responsibilities:

1. Triad Electric shall construct the streetscape along Cowart Street adjacent to the property at 1405 Cowart Street as shown on the City's Streetscape Plan. The work shall include foundations for the Pedestrian Light Poles (PLP), conduits and handhold boxes.
2. Triad Electric shall provide a contribution of \$6,035.04 towards the cost of (4) PLP's and light fixtures.


City Responsibilities:

1. The City is the sole owner of the Pedestrian Light Poles and thus is the only entity approved to order the poles fabricated by Sun Valley, by a competitive bid process. Once payment has been received by Triad Electric the poles shall be ordered.
2. The City shall be responsible for the installation of the electrical wiring, the PLP's, and light fixtures at a cost of \$1,508.76 each.

The City and Triad Electric are in agreement to the above terms as they pertain to the 1405 Cowart Street Streetscape Project and by the execution of signatures below enter into a Partnership Agreement.
