A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE NATIONAL MEDAL OF HONOR MUSEUM OF MILITARY HISTORY C/O JIM WADE, EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, TO USE TEMPORARILY THE RIGHT-OF-WAY LOCATED ON THE SOUTHERN CORNER OF THE INTERSECTION OF SOUTH CREST ROAD AND SOUTH CREST PLACE TO INSTALL THREE (3) MEDAL OF HONOR MARKERS ADJACENT TO THE EXISTING MARKER, AS SHOWN ON THE MAPS ATTACHED HERETO AND MADE A PART HEREOF BY REFERENCE, SUBJECT TO CERTAIN CONDITIONS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, That NATIONAL MEDAL OF HONOR MUSEUM OF MILITARY HISTORY C/O JIM WADE, EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, (hereinafter referred to as “Temporary User”) be and is hereby permitted to use temporarily the right-of-way located on the southern corner of the intersection of South Crest Road and South Crest Place to install three (3) medal of honor markers adjacent to the existing marker, as shown on the maps attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That said temporary usage shall be subject to the following conditions:

1. Temporary User may execute the Indemnification Agreement prior to the granting of a temporary use by the City Council provided that any obligation to Indemnify and hold the City of Chattanooga, its officers, agents and employees harmless for any claims for damages for injuries to persons or property shall be void if the Temporary Use is not granted to applicant by the Chattanooga City Council. Temporary User agrees to comply with all terms and conditions of the Indemnification Agreement in the event a temporary use is granted by the City Council.

2. Temporary User agrees to vacate the property and temporary use upon reasonable notice from the City to do so.

3. Temporary User shall provide adequate access for maintenance of any utilities located within the easement.

4. The markers should not interfere with driver line of sight for any of the affected intersections. To ensure there are no line of sight conflicts, locations are to be approved by CDOT prior to installation.

5. Temporary User shall obtain necessary permits and approvals from the City of Chattanooga Land Development Office.

6. Temporary User shall provide adequate access for maintenance of any utilities located within the easement, is responsible for verifying all utility locations within the subject area prior to initiating the agreed usage, as well as the protection of said utilities for the duration of this permit.

RECOMMENDATION: APPROVAL WITH CONDITIONS

This application was received on September 15, 2015, from Jim Wade, Executive Director of the National Medal of Honor Museum of Military History. The applicant intends to install three (3) Medal of Honor Markers, adjacent to the existing Marker for the Missionary Ridge School.

After review, granting this Temporary Usage does not conflict with the public's interest.

Therefore, I recommend the request for *Temporary Usage be granted with the following conditions:*

RE: Request for Temporary Usage

Dear Mr. Kuyrkendall:

This is a request for temporary usage of 3 Medal of Honor Markers on City "Right of Way" at intersection of 3100 South Crest Place & 100 South Crest Road adjacent to the current Missionary Ridge School Marker.. Tax Map No. 156FP014

The reason for the request is as follows: The National Medal of Honor Museum of Military History is establishing a Medal of Honor Heritage Trail at locations around the City of Chattanooga where actions occurred during the Chickamauga & Chattanooga Campaign in 1863 during the Civil War where 33 Medals of Honor were awarded. Markers are already in place at Chickamauga(3) for the 9 recipients there and on Lookout Mountain(1) for the four recipients there. The initial three signs on Missionary Ridge will cover 10 of the 17 recipients there.. See attached photo of one of three markers being dedicated at the Lee & Gordons Mills in Chickamauga in 2014. These are similar markers to those used by the National Military Park and Brad Bennett, Superintendent of the Chickamauga & Chattanooga National Military park will supply a letter of support for our Heritage Treail if required. See enclosed email of support from Doug Eckert, President of the Missionary Ridge Neighborhood Association. Photo of one of three markers for Missionary Ridge is also enclosed reflecting four of the recipients there to include Lieutenant. Arthur MacArthur.

In making this request: Temporary User agrees as follows:

1. Temporary User shall defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the City of Chattanooga, Tennessee its officers, agents, and employees from any and all claims for damages for injuries to persons or property related to or arising out of the aforementioned temporary use.
2. Temporary User shall comply with any and all conditions recommended by the City Transportation Engineer and/or City Transportation Department and approved by the Chattanooga City Council during the review of this application. The failure to comply with any condition approved by the City Council may be grounds for revocation of this temporary use at any time after its approval
3. Temporary User shall vacate the property and temporary use upon thirty (30) days notice from the City to do so. Upon vacating the property, whether voluntarily or at the request of the City, the Temporary User shall restore the property to substantially the same condition that existed prior to granting the temporary use, including complying with any environmental regulations.
4. Temporary User shall provide full access for maintenance of any utilities located within the easement.
5. Temporary User shall obtain any and all other permits, variances, or approvals necessary to accommodate the temporary use.
6. Temporary User shall maintain the property in the condition equal to or better than the condition at the time the temporary use is granted.
7. If this request is for maintaining wells, the Temporary User shall, upon satisfactory completion of use as determined by the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation, abandon the well using standard and acceptable practices, which shall include grouting from the bottom to top with a mixture of Portland cement and powdered bentonite and restoring the surface to its original condition as reasonably as possible.
