**City of Chattanooga Commioners:**

**We are the Chattanooga Radio Control Club currently leasing the field at the old Summit Landfill. We have been AMA sanctioned #599 and in Chattanooga since 1965. We greatly appreciate the city for this area to safely promote and enjoy our hobby.**

**During the course of the year we hold special events for Siskin Childrens Hospital to raise funds for special needs. We visit schools in our area to promote flying and give education with training at our field. Just to mention a few of our events, we host the Senior Pattern Association, Fun Fly for the public, 3-D Jam, War Bird Events, and we put on demonstrations for the Boy Scouts with all aspects of R/C Model Aircraft including helicopters, drones and gliders. At each or most events tourists and R/C enthusiasts come to our city for three or four days and stay at local hotels. They eat at local restuarants and visit the Chattanooga area. They spend tourist dollars in and all around Chattanooga while in town.**

**As a non-profit organization, we at CRCC do not charge gate admission or profit from any of our events. We have membership dues yearly which provide for our lease payment, up keep of the field, and general maintence with mowing and maintaining grass as the biggest expense.**

**We are approaching you today as a non-profit organization requesting funds for public works. Jim Templeton, director of public works has looked at our situation and has provided an estimate on repaving our exsisting runway and cross runway. We were quoted the price of \$47,200.00 for the city to complete this work. Through club members and private donations we have accumulated \$21,000.00 towards this project.**

**The landfill has sagged greatly over the last twelve years and is in such need of attention that it is becoming hazardous to all of our expensive aircrafts. We feel it is deterring visitors from attending our events due to the deterioration of the asphalt. With this property being owned by the City of Chattanooga we have great hopes that the commission will be of assistance with this project. We have recieved private quotes from \$60,000.00 to \$80,000.00 and our lease contract states that we must have the commissions approval before any work is done. We don't have that type of funding. Most of the equipment necessary to complete the project is already at the site and even some of the city owned material is on site too. These are the reasons we are approaching the commission for assistance with this project. With these improvements we can continue to entice people to visit Chattanooga and provide education to schools and youth groups in a safe enviroment for all model R/C aircraft addicts, fans and supporters.**





