# ORDER1

This case is before the Court pursuant to the motion of defendant City of Chattanooga for approval of the Redistricting Plan for Elections of Members of the City Council ("Redistricting Plan") which the Chattanooga City Council approved as Ordinance 9640 on third and final reading on November 26, 1991. The Redistricting Plan is based on 1990 census figures and has been submitted to this Court for review pursuant to paragraph 20 of the Amended Plan which was a part of the Agreed Order entered by this Court on January 18, 1990. This Court retained jurisdiction for the limited purpose of reviewing this Redistricting Plan pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1973a(c).

No opposition has been filed to the City's motion. A review of the Redistricting Plan reveals on its face that it is in compliance with the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended, 42 U.S.C. §§ 1973 - 1973ff-6, as well as the Equal Protection Clause of the Fourteenth Amendment of the United States Constitution.

It is, therefore, ORDERED that the Redistricting Plan (Ordinance 9640) be, and it hereby is, APPROVED. Therefore, the judgment previously entered in this case is now in all respects FINAL.

## ORDINANCE NO. 9640

AN ORDINANCE REAPPORTIONING THE NINE DISTRICTS FOR CITY COUNCIL AND SCHOOL BOARD POSITIONS AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO SUBMIT THIS REAPPORTIONMENT PLAN TO THE UNITED STATES DISTRICT COURT FOR THE EASTERN DISTRICT OF TENNESSEE, CHATTANOOGA DIVISION.

<u>SECTION 1</u>. WHEREAS, Section 19 of the Court Order in the case of <u>Brown v.</u> <u>Board of Commissioners of the City of Chattanooga, Tennessee</u>, No. Civ-1-87-388, in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Tennessee requires that following the publication of each new official decennial federal census, the Council shall reorganize and adjust by ordinance the boundaries of the council districts; and

WHEREAS, the same section requires that the adjusted districts shall be as equal in population as practicable; and

WHEREAS, the City has now received the official results of the 1990 decennial federal census and is therefore required to redistrict;

## NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, That the nine districts for City Council and School Board positions be and are hereby reapportioned and redistricted so as to provide that the following districts are hereby established for the various council positions:
