AGENDA ITEMS FOR OCTOBER 14, 2008

Ordinance 5(a) regarding distance restrictions for the sale of beer or other beverages of like alcoholic content to the area of Warner Park occupied by the Chattanooga Zoo had already been discussed. Councilwoman Berz asked where we stood on this and was told by Councilwoman Gaines that it is up for final reading tonight.

Resolution 7© authorizes a Memorandum of Understanding with the Chattanooga Eastside Task Force for use of the Avondale, Carver, and Glenwood Recreation Centers to provide positive cultural programs and activities for the area youth as part of the East Chattanooga Weed and Seed Program. Mr. Saylor stated that this falls under the umbrella of the Eastside Task Force and is a good opportunity to serve more young people, and he encouraged the Council to consider this.
