

PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE

August 11, 2009

Councilman Rico, Chairman, called the meeting of the Public Works Committee to order, with Councilmen Benson, Murphy, Berz, Scott, Ladd, McGary and Robinson present. City Attorney Michael McMahan and Shirley Crownover, Assistant Clerk to the Council, were also present.

Adm. Leach went over agenda items, noting that **Ordinance 6(c)** would be withdrawn. Attorney McMahan further added that other solutions were being explored regarding the dispute concerning Aetna Mountain Road, including temporary closure of 1,000 ft. at a time and also annexation had been suggested—that they were going back to the drawing board for solutions.

Ordinance (d) is a closure and abandonment regarding Unum Provident lots, and this is a correction.

Resolution 7(a) concerns new hires as special police officers for Public Works Water Quality Dept. **Resolution (d)** relative to the City Sidewalk Requirements Contract with Yerbey Concrete Construction, Inc. will be deferred for two weeks. **Resolution (e)** is a temporary usage of 2474 Clay Street for Robert E. Sanders to install a directional sign at the corner of Appling Street and Amnicola Highway. It was noted that this is consistent with our policy.

There being nothing for next week, the meeting was adjourned at 3:35 p.m.
