Abandonment of the 1000 block of John Mark Road beginning on the east line of the 5400 block of Winding Land thence some 1100 feet southwestwardly to the 5500 block of Highway 153. Said street separates Lots 69 thru 73 from Lots 59 thru 63 and Lots 75 thru 79, Overall Plan of Northern Hills Subdivision, Plat Book 21, Page 51, ROHC. Tax Map 99L-D-001 thru 008.


