ORDINANCE NO.	11645

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 6958, AS AMENDED, KNOWN AS THE ZONING ORDINANCE, SO AS TO REZONE TRACTS OF LAND LOCATED AT 2324 NAPIER DRIVE, 7315 AND 7318 MCCUTCHEON ROAD, AND 2329, TIMBERLANE TRAIL, MORE 2333. AND 2337 PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED HEREIN. FROM R-1 RESIDENTIAL ZONE TO R-4 SPECIAL ZONE.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, That Ordinance No. 6958, as amended, known as the Zoning Ordinance, be and the same hereby is amended so as to rezone:

Part of Lot 4, Block A, J. L. Jenkins Subdivision, Plat Book 10, Page 49, ROHC, together with Lots 1 thru 3, Timberland Subdivision, Plat Book 20, Page 73, ROHC, Deed Book 4887, Page 40, ROHC, Deed Book 7260, Page 359, Deed Book 7100, Page 865, Deed Book 3009, Page 709, Deed Book 7046, Page 245, and Deed Book 5462, Page 824, ROHC. Tax Map 149H-A-005 thru 007 and 009 thru 011.

from R-1 Residential Zone to R-4 Special Zone.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this rezoning shall be subject to the following conditions:

- Ingress and Egress shall be approved by the City of Chattanooga Traffic Engineer.
- Screening as required by the Landscape Ordinance abutting adjacent residential areas.
 - 3. Lighting shall be directed away from surrounding residences.
 - 4. No apartments.

5. All existing easements are retained.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance shall take effect two (2) weeks from and after its passage, as provided by law.


