ORDINANCE NO. 11905

AN ORDINANCE CLOSING AND ABANDONING A PORTION OF THE 100 BLOCK RIGHT-OF-WAY OF WEST 13<sup>TH</sup> STREET, MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED HEREIN AND AS SHOWN ON THE MAP ATTACHED HERETO AND MADE A PART HEREOF BY REFERENCE, SUBJECT TO CERTAIN CONDITIONS.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, That there be and is hereby closed a portion of the 100 block right-of-way of West 13<sup>th</sup> Street, more particularly described below and as shown on the maps attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference:

Abandonment of a portion of the 100 block right of way of West 13<sup>th</sup> Street beginning at its intersection with the east line of the 1300 block of Broad Street thence northeast some 23 feet, thence southeast some 25 feet, thence following a curve around the northwest property line of Tax Map 145E-V-002.01 some 37 feet to the point of beginning. Said right-of-way separates said Tax Map from the 100 block of West 13<sup>th</sup> Street. Tax Map 145E-V-002.01.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this closure and abandonment shall be subject to Tennessee-American Water Company and BellSouth retaining easements for the full width of the right-of-way.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect two (2) weeks from and after its passage.



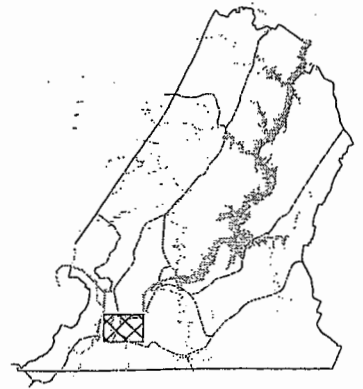

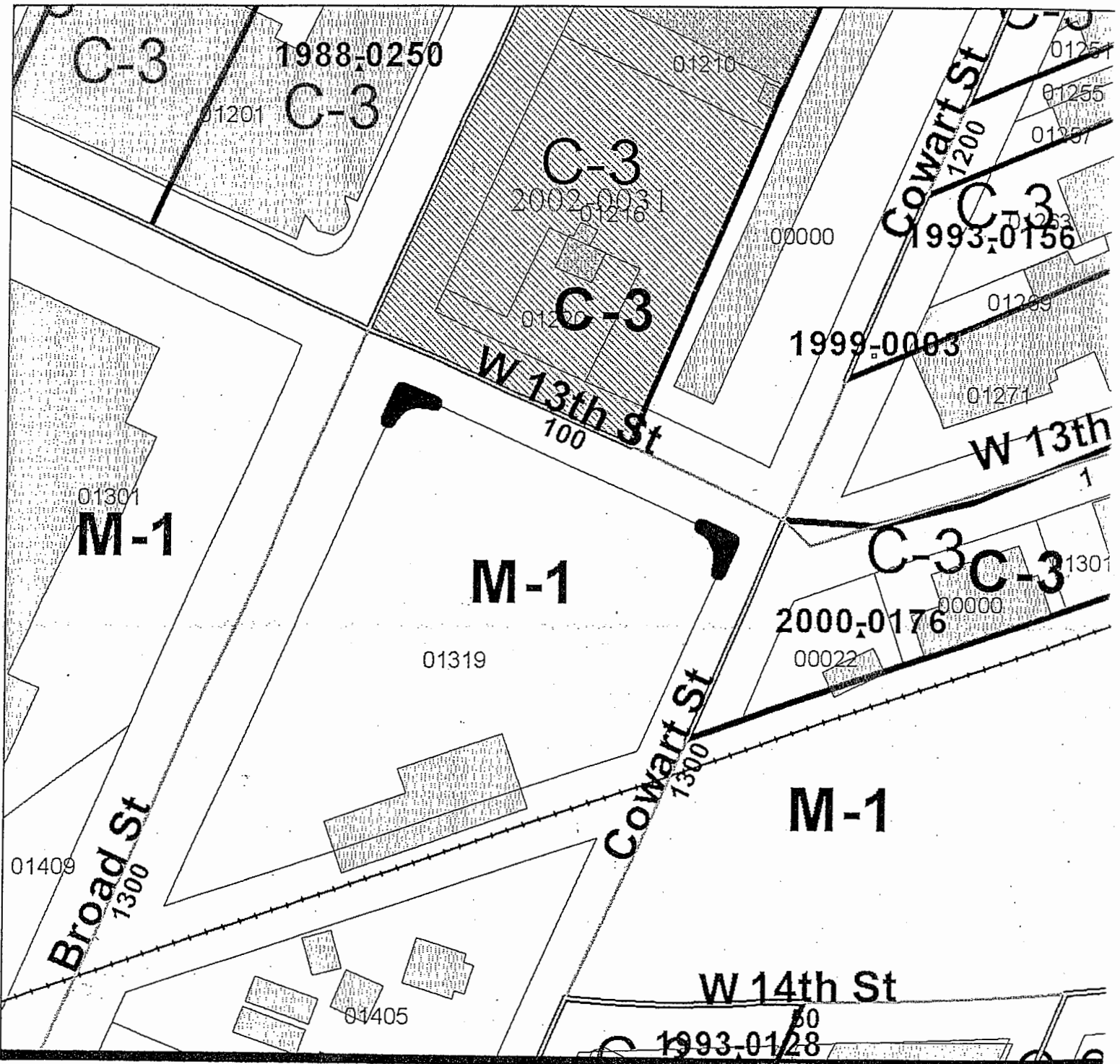
