AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 11994, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE. HEREINAFTER 'THE FISCAL YEAR 2007-2008 BUDGET ORDINANCE', TO PROVIDE REVENUE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2007, AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2008, AND APPROPRIATING SAME TO THE PAYMENT OF EXPENSES OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT; FIXING THE RATE OF TAXATION ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY IN THE CITY, AND THE TIME TAXES AND PRIVILEGES ARE DUE, HOW THEY SHALL BE PAID, WHEN THEY SHALL BECOME DELINQUENT; **PROVIDING** INTEREST AND PENALTY ON DELINQUENT TAXES AND PRIVILEGES," AS AMENDED, **SPECIFICALLY** ORDINANCE NO. 12023, SO AS TO AMEND CITY EMPLOYEE POSITION TITLES AND PAY GRADES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA,
TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 11994, entitled as set forth in the caption hereof, as amended, specifically by Ordinance No. 12023, be and the same is amended as provided hereinafter.

SECTION 2. That the position titles and pay grades set forth in Section 7(b) of Ordinance No. 11994 and Section 3 of Ordinance No. 12023 be and are hereby changed to the titles and pay ranges set forth below. The Administrator of Personnel and personnel staff shall administratively re-classify those employees set forth in said sections of Ordinance Nos. 11994 and 12023 to the appropriate title, pay grade, and range set forth below pursuant to the Factor Evaluation System study recently completed. Employees dissatisfied with their classification may appeal within five (5) days through the administrator of their department and the Administrator of Personnel to the Mayor or his designee(s) with regard to the classification appeals shall be final.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is further amended to provide longevity bonus pay for permanent full time classified service employees who have five (5) or more years of continuous service as of May 31, 2008. The longevity pay shall be twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for each full year of continuous service up to a maximum of thirty (30) years or seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00). Employees terminated before May 31, 2008 shall not qualify for the longevity bonus pay.

<u>SECTION 4</u>. That this ordinance is applicable only to employees still employed by the City as of its effective date.

SECTION 5. That this Ordinance shall be operative, as distinguished from its effective date, on and after January 4, 2008, and the City Finance Officer is authorized to apply any increases in salary caused by said reclassification retroactively to that date and pay the longevity bonuses for all employees earning same as of May 31, 2008.

SECTION 6. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
