## ORDINANCE NO. 12204

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHATTANOOGA CITY CODE, PART II, SECTION 2-542(5), SO AS TO REMOVE THE RESTRICTION THAT A REQUIREMENTS CONTRACT NOT BE LET FOR A PERIOD IN EXCESS OF ONE (1) YEAR.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, That Chattanooga City Code, Part II, Section 2-542(5) be and is hereby amended by deleting said subsection in its entirety and substituting in lieu thereof the following:

(5) He may, subject to the approval of the mayor and city council, advertise for and enter into requirements, blanket, annual orders or indefinite quantity contracts, or term contracts. No such contract shall be let unless the same shall have been first advertised for bids as required by section 2-552. Such contracts must contain a provision giving the city the right of cancellation at any time with no more than one (1) year's notice, and at the end of any fiscal year without notice in the event that funds to support the contract become unavailable and no such contract may be let for periods of time in excess of sixty (60) months.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance and the Code

amended hereby shall become effective two (2) weeks from and after its passage.
