A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA TO SUBMIT A REQUEST FOR FEDERAL FUNDING FOR THE PROJECTS SET FORTH HEREIN FROM OUR FEDERAL ELECTED REPRESENTATIVES INCLUDING THE OFFICES OF CONGRESSMAN ZACH WAMP AND SENATORS' LAMAR ALEXANDER AND BOB CORKER.

WHEREAS, The City of Chattanooga and Hamilton County have often worked together to help secure federal funding with the aid of our local elected federal delegation, and

WHEREAS, Additional support is needed to carry out many of these worthwhile projects, and

WHEREAS, A resolution has been requested from all jurisdictions seeking federal appropriations, and

WHEREAS, This resolution wishes to offer support for the following federal funding requests:

- 1. HIGHWAY 58 CONNECTOR ROAD TO ENTERPRISE SOUTH**
- 2. RAIL PROJECTS AT ENTERPRISE SOUTH INCLUDING:**
 - 2A. ADDITIONAL RAIL CAPACITY
 - 2B. RAIL UPGRADES
 - 2C. LOW EMISSION LOCOMATIVE
 - 2D. CROSSING SIGNAL PROTECTION
 - 2E. GRADE SEPARATION
- 3. RIVERWALK EXPANSTION**
 - 3A. FROM ALSTOM TO US PIPE AND ST. ELMO
 - 3B. FROM RENAISSANCE PARK TO MOCCASIN BEND
- 4. REGIONAL LAW ENFORCEMENT TRAINING CENTER**
