

RESOLUTION NO. 26741

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND RESOLUTION NO. 26615 BY CHANGING THE AMOUNT OF FISCAL YEAR 2011-2012 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT AND HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIP ACT FUNDS TO BE AWARDED BY THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD) AND PROGRAM INCOME TO THREE MILLION THREE HUNDRED TWO THOUSAND THIRTY-SIX DOLLARS (\$3,302,036.00), TO INCLUDE AWARDED FUNDS FROM TENNESSEE HOUSING DEVELOPMENT AGENCY (THDA) IN THE AMOUNT OF EIGHTY-FOUR THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$84,000.00), AND TO CHANGE THE DISTRIBUTION OF THE FUNDS AS SHOWN FULLY HEREIN.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 26615, encaptioned "A resolution approving the acceptance and distribution of Fiscal Year 2011-2012 Community Development Block Grant and Home Investment Partnership Act funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and program income, all totaling approximately \$3,690,000.00, as shown more fully hereinbelow," on March 8, 2011, the City Council of Chattanooga, Tennessee authorized the acceptance and distribution of Fiscal Year 2011-2012 Community Development Block Grant and HOME Investment Partnership Act Funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and program income, all totaling approximately \$3,690,000.00 and the distribution as shown below; and
