

RESOLUTION NO. 27091

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR, AND ACCEPT, A 2012 JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT FOR THE PURCHASE OF RADAR UNITS AND PATROL RIFLE MOUNTS FOR THE CHATTANOOGA POLICE DEPARTMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED FORTY-THREE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED FOUR DOLLARS (\$143,904.00) WITH FORTY-SIX THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED EIGHTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$46,585.00) OF THIS GRANT GOING TO THE HAMILTON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Justice guidelines require a joint submission with the City of Chattanooga for a 2012 Justice Assistance Grant (JAG); and,

WHEREAS, the 2012 JAG will be divided with the City of Chattanooga receiving \$143,904.00 and Hamilton County receiving \$46,585.00; and;

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office will use the 2012 JAG to purchase radar units and patrol rifle mounts; and,

WHEREAS, no match is required; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, That it is hereby authorizing the Mayor to apply for, and accept, a 2012 Justice Assistance Grant for the purchase of radar units and patrol rifle mounts for the Chattanooga Police Department and approving the use of this grant by the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office.
