We, Mrs. W. F. Butler and Mrs. Thomas B. Heys, President and Secretary, respectively, of The Wesley Community Center, and Mrs. T. E. Mynatt and Mrs. James P. Cornelison, President and Secretary, respectively, of The John and Elizabeth Caldwell Memorial Bethlehem House, both corporations chartered and organized under the laws of the State of Tennessee, hereby certify that, at a regular meeting called for such purpose more than two-thirds of the Directors and Membership of each of said corporations adopted resolutions declaring it to be the desire of the Directors and Membership of each of said corporations to consolidate or merge the two corporations with the following provisions:

1. The name of the consolidated or merged corporation shall be

METHODIST NEIGHBORHOOD CENTERS, INC.  
of Chattanooga, Tennessee.

2. The purpose of this organization shall be:

To share the abundant life in Christ through a program of service to our fellowman.

To be aware of the needs of the neighborhoods served and to take positive action toward resolving them by establishing direct services and through cooperative action with other community groups.

To provide experiences that make for enrichment and growth in the lives of the participants of all ages, backgrounds, beliefs and capabilities.

To foster understanding between groups.

To strengthen family life and maintain a close relation with the neighborhood.

3. Membership shall be as follows:

a. The minister of each local Methodist church within the bounds of the Chattanooga District of The Methodist Church, plus representatives from:

- (1) Woman's Society of Christian Service/Wesleyan Service Guild
- (2) Commission on Missions
- (3) Commission on Christian Social Concerns
- (4) Methodist Men
- (5) Methodist Youth Fellowship.

- b. The District Superintendent.

Page Two - Amendment to Charter of Incorporation of The Wesley Community Center and The John and Elizabeth Caldwell Memorial Bethlehem House.

- c. Officers of the Conference Woman's Society of Christian Service residing in area.
  - d. Officers of the Jurisdiction Woman's Society of Christian Service residing in area.
  - e. Any member of the Board of Missions residing in the area.
  - f. The District Woman's Society of Christian Service.
  - g. The Conference Woman's Society of Christian Service.
  - h. One representative from the Conference Board of Missions.
  - i. The President of the District Board of Missions and Church Extension.
  - j. Residents of the Neighborhoods of Bethlehem Community Center and Miriam A. Brock Wesley Center and the community-at-large; provided, however, that the combined number of persons entitled to participate under this provision shall not exceed forty-nine (49%) per cent of the total members present and voting.
4. The Board of Directors shall consist of:

Thirty elected adult members of the Corporation who are interested in the welfare of the neighborhood's served by it.

At least fifty-one (51%) per cent of the elected membership of the Board must be members of The Methodist Church. At least ten (10%) per cent shall be residents of the neighborhoods served.

The following shall be ex-officio members:

District Superintendent or representative.  
District President W. S. C. S. and Treasurer.  
Conference President W. S. C. S. or representative.  
Officers of the Conference Woman's Society of Christian Service residing in area.  
Officers of the Jurisdiction Woman's Society of Christian Service residing in area.  
Conference Board of Missions representative.  
Any member of the Board of Missions residing in area.  
The President of District Board of Missions and Church Extension.

In event that Methodist Neighborhood Centers, Inc., shall cease to be operated by or affiliated with an agency or agencies of The Methodist Church or its legal successor, then this corporation shall discontinue the use of the name "Methodist" in its corporate name and shall not thereafter display or use or authorize others to use the name "Methodist".

Now, therefore, we hereby certify to the adoption of said resolutions by the Directors and Membership of said corporations for the

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 48-303 of the Tennessee General Corporation Act, the undersigned corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to its charter:

1. The name of the corporation is "Methodist Neighborhood Centers, Inc."

2. The amendment adopted is:

"NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that in event of dissolution, the residual assets of the organization will be turned over to the Chattanooga District Board of Missions and Church Extension, Inc. of the United Methodist Church, or the National Division of the Board of Missions of the United Methodist Church, which themselves are exempt as organizations described in Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or corresponding sections of any prior or future Internal Revenue Code, or to the Federal, State, or Local Government for exclusive public purpose.

"This applies only to the Good Shepherd Fold and the parking lot (Lot 16) at Wesley Community Center. Title to the John and Elizabeth Caldwell Memorial Bethlehem House and the Wesley Community Center is in the name of the Women's Society of Christian Service."

3. The amendment was duly adopted at a meeting of the members on May 16, 1971.

4. The amendment shall become effective when filed in the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of Tennessee.

Gentlemen:

Based on information supplied, and assuming your operations will be as stated in your application for recognition of exemption, we have determined you are exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. We have further determined you are not a private foundation within the meaning of section 509(a) of the Code, because you are an organization described in section 170(b)(1)(A)(vi).

You are not liable for social security (FICA) taxes unless you file a waiver of exemption certificate as provided in the Federal Insurance Contributions Act. You are not liable for the taxes imposed under the Federal Unemployment Tax Act (FUTA).

Since you are not a private foundation, you are not subject to the excise taxes under Chapter 42 of the Code. However, you are not automatically exempt from other Federal excise taxes.

Donors may deduct contributions to you as provided in section 170 of the Code. Bequests, legacies, devises, transfers, or gifts to you or for your use are deductible for Federal estate and gift tax purposes under sections 2055, 2106, and 2522 of the Code.

If your purposes, character, or method of operation is changed, you must let us know so we can consider the effect of the change on your exempt status. Also, you must inform us of all changes in your name or address.

If your gross receipts each year are normally more than \$5,000, you are required to file Form 990, Return of Organization Exempt From Income Tax, by the 15th day of the fifth month after the end of your annual accounting period. The law imposes a penalty of \$10 a day, up to a maximum of \$5,000, for failure to file a return on time.

You are not required to file Federal income tax returns unless you are subject to the tax on unrelated business income under section 511 of the Code. If you are subject to this tax, you must file an income tax return on Form 990-T. In this letter we are not determining whether any of your present or proposed activities are unrelated trade or business as defined in section 513 of the Code.

You need an employer identification number even if you have no employees. If an employer identification number was not entered on your application, a number will be assigned to you and you will be advised of it. Please use that number on all returns you file and in all correspondence with the Internal Revenue Service.


