North River Civic Center is currently accepting applications from visual artists to exhibit in the center's exhibition space. This is an ongoing call for entries with exhibition openings starting May, 2008. Exhibits may feature the work of a single artist, a complimentary small group exhibit, or a themed exhibit.

Eligibility

Professional artists working in any fine art or fine craft medium residing in Chattanooga metropolitan area are eligible to apply for exhibition. Professional artist will be defined as one who is actively pursuing a career in the visual arts.

Who would be ineligible to apply?

Non-professionals who engage in their art as a hobby are not eligible. Artists that have exhibited at North River Civic Center within the last year are also ineligible. Youth exhibits will be determined on a case by case basis.

Evaluation of Application

Submitted applications will be evaluated based on the quality of work represented. The selection panel reserves the right to accept or reject submitted works.

Criteria

All work must be original and completed by the submitting artist within the last four years. Artists slated to exhibit may offer their work for sale under the following conditions:

- The artist will determine the prices of designated artwork.
- The option of P.O.R. (Price On Request) or N.F.S. (Not For Sale) is at the discretion of the artist.
- The North River Civic Center is not a representative for the artist.
- **The North River Civic Center will receive 25% donation from the sale of the exhibited work.**

Preparation of the Artwork

All work(s) must be submitted in a "ready to hang" state:

Two-Dimensional Media

Must be matted (if appropriate); framed and matted works should use glass, acrylic, Plexiglas or Lucite (if appropriate to the individual work). If the work is to be shipped non-glass materials must be used. All frames must have either eye hooks or mounting clips and have un-frayed picture wire or sufficient strength to accommodate the weight of the work. Un-stretched canvases cannot be accommodated, please call center manager for more details.

Important: Work selected for exhibition may not be removed from the exhibition without prior arrangement before the close of the exhibition.

Delivery and Return of Artwork

Accepted works may be hand delivered. The civic center is not responsible for charges stemming from the shipment of artwork. It is the artist's responsibility to make arrangements for delivery prior to the exhibition as well as pick up of said artworks after the close of the exhibition. The artist/artists are also responsible for insurance coverage while the work is being transported to and from the civic center.

Liability

By the mutual agreement between the artist and North River Civic Center (NRCC) to participate in the exhibition, the art/artists agree not to hold the NRCC responsible for any loss or damage during the

exhibition, delivery, or storage of the artwork. The Exhibition Coordinator and designated staff will take due care when handling artwork but is not responsible for damage due to poor construction, framing, wiring or other inherent problems in the art work.

The Exhibition Coordinator, and when called upon, the Friends of the North River Civic Center Committee, reserves the right to make the final selection of all works to be displayed in the designated exhibition space.
