Sealed Bids for furnishing all materials, labor, tools, equipment and appurtenances necessary for the construction of the Agawela Drive Stream Restoration Project will be received at the City of Chattanooga at City Hall, Purchasing Department, Suite G13, 101 East 11th Street, Chattanooga, TN 37402, until 2:00 p.m., local time, on March 24, 2016, and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud.

A Pre-Bid Conference is scheduled for March 10, 2016 at 10:00 A.M. local time, in the Training Facility, Moccasin Bend Wastewater Treatment Plant, 455 Moccasin Bend Road, Chattanooga, TN 37405. A Site Visit Meeting will occur directly after the pre-bid meeting. Bidder attendance to the Pre-Bid Conference and Site Visit Meeting is mandatory.

The Project consists of constructing approximately 1500 linear feet of stream restoration/stabilization using natural design methodologies. A summary of the improvements include excavation and borrow embankment for channel construction, installation of rock and log grade control structures, 60 linear feet of sanitary sewer replacement and encasement, live staking, tree and shrub planting, and sediment/erosion control measures.

Each Bid must be accompanied by a Bid Bond, prepared on the form of Bid Bond attached to the Contract Documents or a Surety Company's Standard Bid Bond, duly executed by the Bidder as principal and having as surety thereon a surety company licensed to do business in the State of Tennessee and listed as a certified company in the latest issue of U.S. Treasury Circular 570, in the amount of five percent of the Bid.

The total allotted time for construction is 240 calendar days. The allotted time for substantial

completion is 180 calendar days. The allotted time for final completion is 60 days which includes 30 days to install planting. Live stake planting must occur between November 15th and March 15th.

No bid may be withdrawn within 120 calendar days after the scheduled time for receipt of bids.

All bidders must be licensed and shall comply with all requirements of the State of Tennessee Contractor's Licensing Act.
