Separate sealed bids for furnishing all supervision, materials, labor, tools, equipment, and appliances necessary for the construction of the following described project, will be received by the City of Chattanooga at City Hall, Purchasing Department, Suite G13, located at 101 E. 11th Street, Chattanooga, TN 37402, until 2:00 p.m., local time, on **March 20, 2014** and then at said place publicly opened and read aloud:

Enterprise South Industrial Park Sanitary Sewer Upgrade, Phase 2

The U.S. Department of Commerce Economic Development Administration is providing partial funding for this project (EDA Award Number 04-79-06577)

The scope of work shall consist of two separate operations including but not limited to the following:

Installation complete-in-place of approximately 900 l.f. of 10" diameter PVC gravity sanitary sewer pipe, 8,540 l.f. of 36" diameter CCFRPM gravity sanitary sewer pipe, 5,100 l.f. of 18" diameter fusion welded HDPE sanitary sewer force main, approximately 441 l.f. of 30" diameter welded steel casing pipe installed by bore and jack method, approximately 212 l.f. of 30" diameter welded steel casing pipe installed by open cut method, approximately 587 l.f. of 54" diameter welded steel casing pipe installed by bore and jack method, manholes, air release valve assemblies, two interim and three final non-clog submersible wastewater pumps in existing pump station with associated base elbow/discharge fittings and guide rails, lifting chains, ductile iron station piping with ceramic epoxy lining, valves, fittings, concrete pipe supports, variable frequency drives, motor control centers, mechanical and electrical equipment and connections, one new magnetic flow meter, one new diesel powered electric generator on concrete pad, fall protection at existing wet well and valve pit openings, new pump access hatch, and associated appurtenances for a complete and operational system. Project includes clearing and grading, as required, pumping out existing wet well, coring existing concrete pump well walls, fastening pipe and rails to existing concrete pump station walls, security fence relocations and construction, installation of an electrical control building with required environmental controls on a new concrete slab for housing variable frequency drives and control equipment, sawcutting existing pavement, trench excavation, and backfill, removal and reinstallation of existing concrete pavers, roadway repaving, permeable pavement installation, installation and maintenance of traffic controls in accordance with the MUTCD, sanitary sewer flow control, connections to existing gravity sanitary sewers and force mains, as required, plugging existing sanitary sewers, as required, testing installed pipe and manholes, as required, pavement trench repairs, erosion control, final stabilization, payment of all required inspection and permitting fees, and other necessary improvements for a complete and operational system.

Sequence of Work

The contractor shall refer to Specification Section 01015 – Sequence of Work. This Specification is definitive and overrides any other sequencing conflicts in the contract documents.

The allotted time for construction is 270 calendar days.

State and Federal funds will be involved in this project, and, as a result, Bidders must comply with the SRF Loan Program's Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE) requirements including contacting a minimum of 10 qualified DBE sub-contractors, professional service providers, vendors, and/or suppliers by certified mail to solicit bids. The apparent successful Bidder must submit to the Owner copies of the certified letters and return receipts prior to contract award. Neither the State of Tennessee nor any of its departments, agencies, or employees is or will be a party to this Invitation for Bids or any resulting contract(s) awarded by the Owner.
