# Affordable Housing Initiative (AHI)

The City of Chattanooga is making available HOME Investment Partnership Act (HOME) grant funds under its Affordable Housing Initiative for the development of rental housing units for individuals and families. The grant funds may be used to construct and rehab housing units within the city limits of Chattanooga.

Area developers, nonprofits, and for-profit organizations may apply as single applicants or in partnership with other entities. Partnerships are encouraged but not required for this program.
