The City of Chattanooga, in partnership with the Benwood Foundation and Choo Choo Partners, L.P., is improving the East 14th Street corridor through the 14th Street Streetscape Improvement project. Project construction is scheduled to begin **March 14, 2016**. During construction, East 14th Street will be closed to vehicle and pedestrian traffic from Market Street to Rossville Avenue, as shown on the map below. The work on East 14th Street will include the replacement of a water main by Tennessee American Water, installation of stormwater management infrastructure, and construction of a new streetscape. Construction is scheduled to be completed by the end of May, with East 14th Street scheduled to reopen by **June 1, 2016**. Construction schedule is subject to delay due to weather or unforeseen circumstances. We will contact you with any changes to the anticipated schedule.

The goals for the project include more effective stormwater management within the City's combined sewer area, traffic calming, enhanced safety for all users, and an increased sense of place between Market Street and Rossville Avenue.

The City of Chattanooga embraces initiatives that unify goals across departments and maximize the efforts of all partners. It is our hope that this project will serve as a standard for future streetscape improvement opportunities.
