



Official Dig/Tent Erection Request Form

City Of Chattanooga Parks, Recreation, Arts and Culture

Before digging in the Parks or erecting a tent with stakes longer than 1 foot, two parties must be notified no less than 72 hours in advance. You are required by law to notify Tennessee One Call at 800-351-1111 of your intent to dig. Chattanooga Parks Facilities Maintenance at (423) 643-6063 or 643-6062 is the second party that must be notified 72 hours before any digging may start.

This form is to notify Chattanooga Parks Facilities Maintenance only. You are required to notify Tennessee One Call in addition to completing this form.

Tennessee One Call is notified to mark public utilities (electric, gas, and telecommunications) that may be located within the potential digging area.

Chattanooga Parks Maintenance is notified to mark any private utilities that may be located within the potential digging area.

There are **no exceptions** to the 72-hour notification process prior to digging. The 72 hours includes only normal workdays of Mon-Fri. Therefore, to dig on Monday at 8:00 AM you must notify both parties before Wednesday 8:00 AM of the week
