Neighborhood Grant Program launches for Fall

Chattanooga, TN— The Neighborhood Services Department of the City of Chattanooga will launch their Neighborhood Grant Program for this Fall with a technical assistance workshop on Thursday, August 26th, 6pm at the Development Resource Center.

Grants are awarded to neighborhood associations and community organizations that present well developed projects to the Neighborhood Services Department, based on several project categories including economic development and neighborhood development.

This year's Neighborhood Grant Program will be highly competitive, with a maximum \$5000 allocation awarded. Last year's grantees presented excellent projects, effectively raising the bar for project submissions. The grantees must be able to demonstrate their ability to match the award at 33%.

Additionally, first-time applicants can receive up to \$1000 without matching contributions.

The deadline for receiving applications is Thursday, September 9th at 4:00pm. Applications received after the deadline will be omitted from the selection process.
